ADAPTED PHYSICAL EDUCATION SPECIALIST (TRAVELING)

JD 4119.4

Definition:

A certificated person who is a specialist who provides a developmental and corrective motor program for identified children who may not benefit from a regular physical education program.

Responsible To:

Coordinator of Special Education

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Develops a system for identifying students with exceptional needs in physical education.
- 2. Provides a developmental and corrective motor program through an Individual Education Plan for identified students at assigned schools.
- 3. Assists classroom teachers in understanding the needs of identified students.
- 4. Provides staff development, as needed, for teachers in Developmental and Corrective Motor Activities as a basic part of learning.
- 5. Participates in Student Study Team meetings, as necessary.
- 6. Evaluates each student's progress and report to parents/guardians, in writing, and at parent conferences.
- 7. Orders and maintains equipment and materials for their program of instruction.
- 8. Performs other duties as may be assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 9. Valid California Teaching Credential with a major in Adapted Physical Education or
- 10. Valid California Teaching Credential with an authorization to teach Adapted Physical Education.
- 11. Knowledge of child growth and development.
