DISTRICT PSYCHOLOGIST

Definition:

A certificated person who provides services as requested. These services include psycho-educational assessment and diagnosis of specific learning, emotional and behavioral disabilities including, but not limited to, case study evaluation, recommendations for remediation or placement, or other pertinent psycho educational interventions, and periodic reevaluation of such children.

Responsible To:

Coordinator of Special Education

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Provides psychological counseling and other techniques with children and parents, including parent education.
2. Conducts assessment and diagnosis of specific learning, emotional and behavioral disabilities of students.
3. Consults with parents to assist in understanding the learning and adjustment processes of children.
4. Consults with teachers in the development and implementation of classroom methods and procedures designed to facilitate pupil learning and to overcome learning and behavioral disorders.
5. Consults with school administrators regarding appropriate learning objectives for children, planning of developmental and remedial programs for students in regular and special school programs.
6. Refers and consults with various community agencies. May serve as a liaison between the school, the family and community resources.
7. Participates in Student Study Team meetings at schools, as needed.
8. Performs other duties as may be assigned.

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Minimum Qualifications:

1. Masters Degree in Counseling and/or related field.
2. School Psychologist Credential or Standard Designated Psychologist Credential
3. This is a non-management position.
