## **DRIVER TRAINER**

### Definition

Under general supervision, to train new drivers and conduct refresher courses for current drivers; to provide an in service training program for bus drivers; to drive a school bus in emergency, relief or extra assignment circumstances; and to do related work as required.

### Responsible to

Scheduler/Dispatcher

### Examples of Duties

1. Accompanies drivers to analyze driving proficiency, as directed, and offers suggestions for maintaining or improving driving proficiency.

- 2. Conducts safety and training classes for bus drivers.
- 3. Reads and explains legislation which applies to drivers.

4. Conducts training sessions for new drivers on bus regulations, state laws and Motor Vehicle Code.

- 5. Conducts behind wheel training for now drivers.
- 6. Holds required instruction and classes for Bus Driver certificate renewal.
- 7. Renders First Aid or emergency assistance, as needed.
- 8. Drives a bus, as needed.
- 9. Operates all transportation equipment skillfully and safely.
- 10. Perform other duties as may be assigned.

#### **Qualifications Guide**

#### Knowledge of

1. Safe driving practices.

2. Provisions of the California Motor Vehicle Code and the Education Code applicable to the operation of vehicles in transporting school children.

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- 3. First aid practices and procedures.
- 4. Geography of the school District and other districts served.
- 5. Record keeping procedures.

## Ability to

- 1. Maintain accurate records and prepare correct reports.
- 2. Conduct classroom and behind-the-wheel training sessions.
- 3. Operate a school bus safely and efficiently.
- 4. Understand, carry out and give oral and written instructions.

5. Establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, the public and staff members.

### Training and Experience

Three years of experience in traffic and transportation work; equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade; or any combination of training and experience that could likely provide the desired knowledge and abilities; must be a graduate of California State School Bus Drivers Course.

#### Licenses

Possession of a valid California Driver's License, Class B, a California School Bus Driver's Certificate, accompanied by a current medical certificate, a School Bus Driver Training Certificate; and the ability to qualify for District vehicle insurance coverage.
