HOME HOSPITAL TEACHER

Definition:

A certificated person who provides instruction of a tutorial basis to students who are homebound or hospitalized because of a physical and/or emotional disability, which prevents them from attending school.

Responsible To:

School Principal, Iowa Street School

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Instruct homebound or hospitalized students on a tutorial basis in various required subjects, until they are able to return to their regular classroom.
- 2. Confers with the student's regular classroom teacher or counselor regarding course of studies, textbooks, credit status, and other details, so as to coordinate instruction with that of the school and classroom from which the student came and to which he will return.
- 3. Counsel's parents/guardians regarding factors in the home, which will make for most effective home instruction.
- 4. Recommends to appropriate staff committee or administrator various books, instructional aids, supplies, and equipment which should be ordered for home study purposes.
- 5. Keeps abreast of curriculum requirements for grades and subjects in all areas studied by student.
- 6. Reports to Iowa Street School, the average-daily attendance and other required statistical information.
- 7. Performs other duties as may be assigned.
