TEACHER - DE LUZ OUTDOOR EDUCATION PROGRAM

Definition:

A certificated person who provides instruction to elementary students, in Outdoor Science at the De Luz Outdoor Education Site; assists the classroom teacher in preparing the classes for De Luz instructional visits, as well as follow-up instruction; serves as a general resource to teachers for the District's Science Curriculum.

Responsible To:

Assistant Superintendent, Educational Services

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Plans, schedules, and carries out an Outdoor Education Program on a continuing basis.
- 2. Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior in cooperation with the visiting classroom teachers.
- 3. Identifies maintenance needs.
- 4. Prepares evaluation reports, as necessary.
- 5. Plans and coordinates the work of the Outdoor Education Program assistant.
- 6. Is able to work harmoniously with parents and District staff.
- 7. Develops and uses lesson plans and instructional materials suitable for verbal and/or visual instruction of students with wide ranges of mental, physical and emotional maturities.
- 8. Creates and maintains, with assistance from students, a functional, effective and attractive environment for learning through displays, bulletin boards, and interest centers.
- 9. Maintains professional competence through participation in in-service education activities provided by the District and/or self-selected professional growth activities.
- 10. Participates cooperatively with the Assistant Superintendent, Educational Services, or his designee, to develop, mutually, the system by which will be evaluated in conformance with the District's uniform guidelines for evaluation and assessment.
- 11. Supervises students in out-of-classroom activities during the assigned working day.
- 12. Participates in curriculum and other developmental programs within the school of assignment and/or on a District level.

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- 13. Contributes to the development and/or improvement of professional standards.
- 14. Performs other duties as may be assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. Valid California Elementary Teaching Credential
- 2. Major in Science Instruction and knowledge of environmental education, ecology, and related science strands desirable.
- 3. Previous teaching experience with elementary students.
