



Dear Parent or Guardian:

You may have heard recently that California Governor Gavin Newsom shared his opinion that schools may not reopen this school year. We understand this information is unsettling, but as of now, the Fallbrook Union Elementary School District has no definitive date on when schools will reopen. All decisions about reopening will be made in conjunction with local public health officials.

While we are uncertain how long this closure will last, we are putting plans in place that will provide students with resources they need. We encourage you to think in both the short- and long-term as well. Here are some resources to assist you.

- We have digital learning and paper-based resources available that we encourage you and your students to utilize while schools are closed.
- We are currently developing a streamlined process for families to check out a Chromebook for home use during school closures. Chromebooks will be made available starting sometime next week.
- We encourage you to stay informed of the situation by regularly checking updates from San Diego County Public Health Services and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. San Diego County Public Health Department updates its website daily with information about COVID-19 and related emergency orders. Please check this site regularly and adhere to all orders and recommendations.
