



Dear Parent or Guardian:

Earlier today, you may have heard Governor Gavin Newsom and State Superintendent of Public Instruction Tony Thurmond address the public regarding the closure of California public schools. Governor Newsom asked all California schools to continue online and distance learning to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Given this state-wide direction, FUESD, along with school districts throughout San Diego County, is following this safety-first approach and will extend our school facility closures through the end of the school year. However, in the future, if the stay-at-home order is lifted and the COVID-19 situation improves, we will do our best to re-open school facilities.

To be clear, the 2019-20 school year is not over. While our schools may be physically closed, our district has been working diligently to provide students and families with the resources they need to learn and stay safe at home. Below are a few selected resources that we think will be helpful to FUESD families:

- Our Child Nutrition Team will continue to provide “Grab and Go” meals for children 18 years of age and younger five days a week. Meals are available for pickup at select school sites Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Families will receive two days’ worth of meals at a time to ensure healthy, consistent meals for all children Monday through Friday. - Our district has made digital learning and paper-based resources available for you and your children to utilize while schools are closed.
