

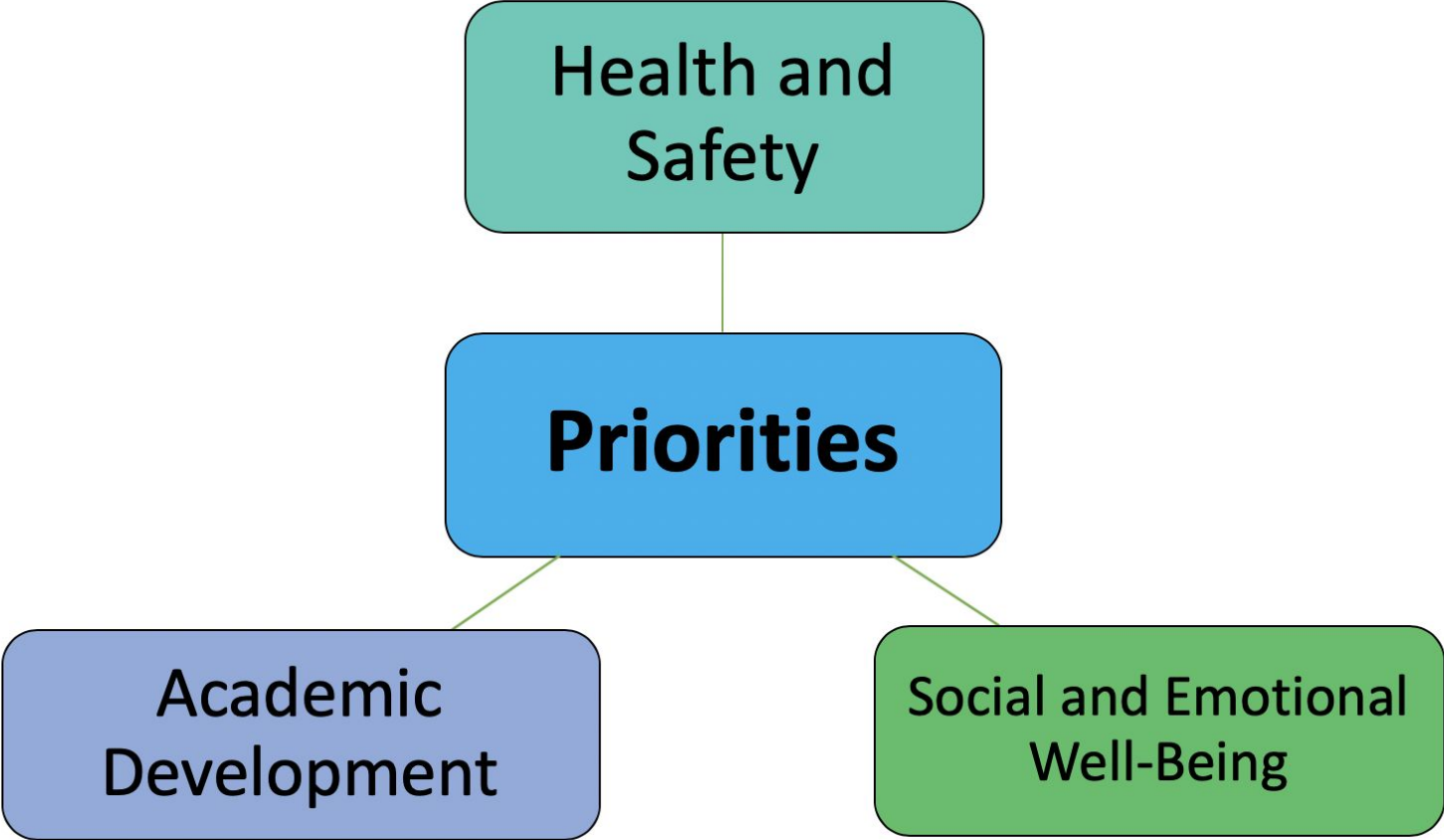

Continuum of Possible Learning Environments

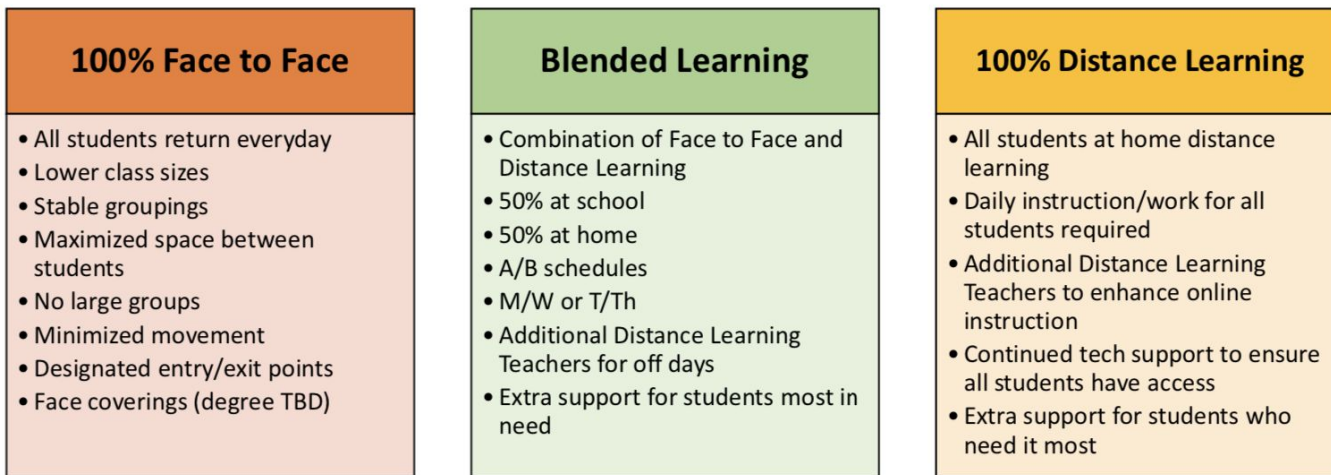
No matter what the reopening plan, we will implement safety protocols to the highest degree possible for students and staff.

FUESD Continuum of Learning Environments for ALL Students



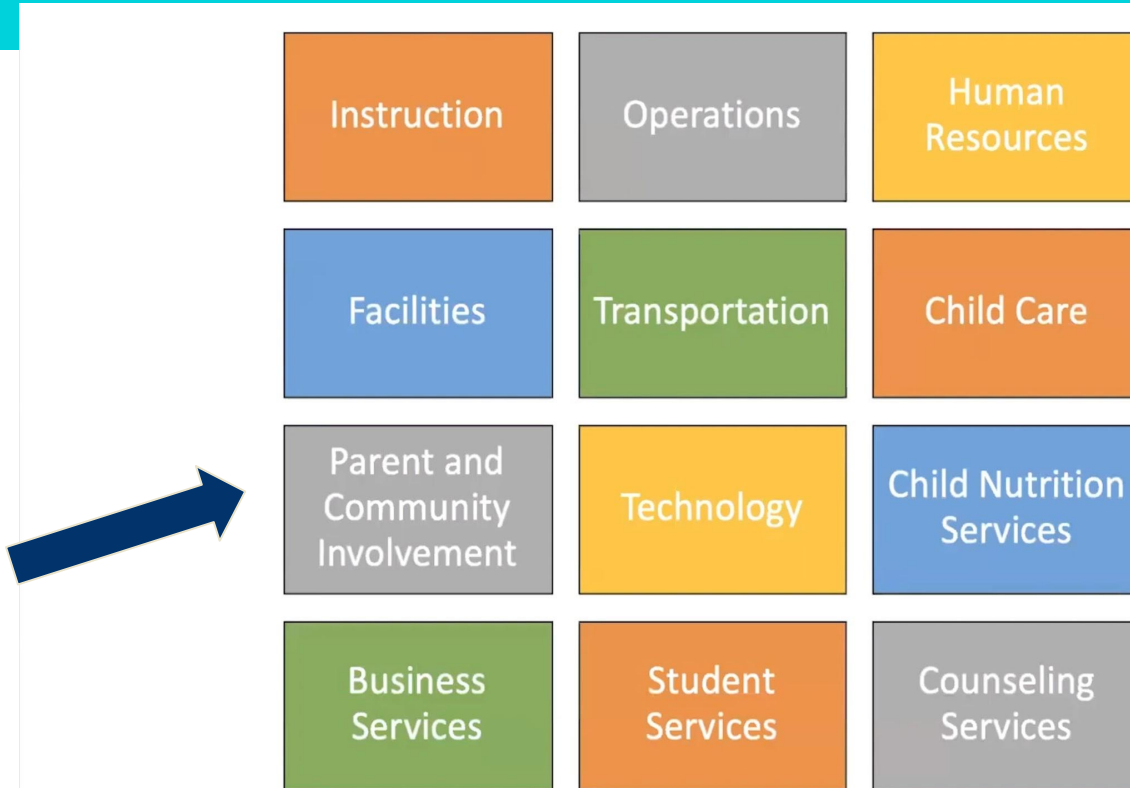
Options for Sustained "At Home" Learning	
<p><u>Option 1:</u> 100% Online Program – Taught by FUESD Teachers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Daily instruction and independent work required 5 days a week online Schedule created by FUESD teachers Tech support for students and parents Extra support for students most in need 	<p><u>Option 2:</u> 100% Homeschooling – Taught by Parents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Option for new and continuing homeschool students 5 days a week at home Flexible schedule based on family needs Weekly check-ins with FUESD teacher Must meet requirements to participate
