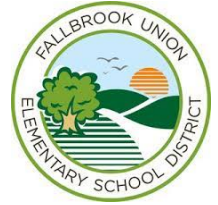




At-Home COVID-19 Testing for FUESD Students Before Returning from Isolation Due to Positive COVID-19 Test or Symptoms



Step 1: Test Kit and Instructions

- A box that has two (2) Antigen Rapid Tests and instructions are available by video and are also provided as an insert in the box. Please scan the appropriate QR code below to access the instructional video via YouTube.

Step 2: Test your student

- Students should test as soon as possible when symptoms start.
- If the first test is negative, test again the following day to confirm the results
- If your student tested positive and is currently isolated at home, wait until day 5 to test again.

Step 3: Understand your test results

Negative results:

- If your student's [COVID-19 symptoms](#) are resolving, your student has been fever-free for 24 hours (without medicine) and your student has TWO negative tests (taken 1 day apart) return to school
- If your student's tests are negative but is still feeling sick, remain at home. Your child may return without testing again if symptoms are improving and fever is not present for 24hrs without medication.
- If the student has been in contact with someone with COVID-19, please call the school before they return **EVEN IF THE TEST IS NEGATIVE**. More testing might be needed

Positive results:

- Stay home from school and contact your school nurse to determine when your student can return to school.

If the test results **are not clear**:

- Contact the school for the next steps, or visit the centralized testing center on the lower side of the campus at Maie Ellis Elementary School or find a local testing site to retest.

Step 4: Report your results to the school

- Negative results do not need to be sent to the school.
- Parents notify the school of positive results.
