

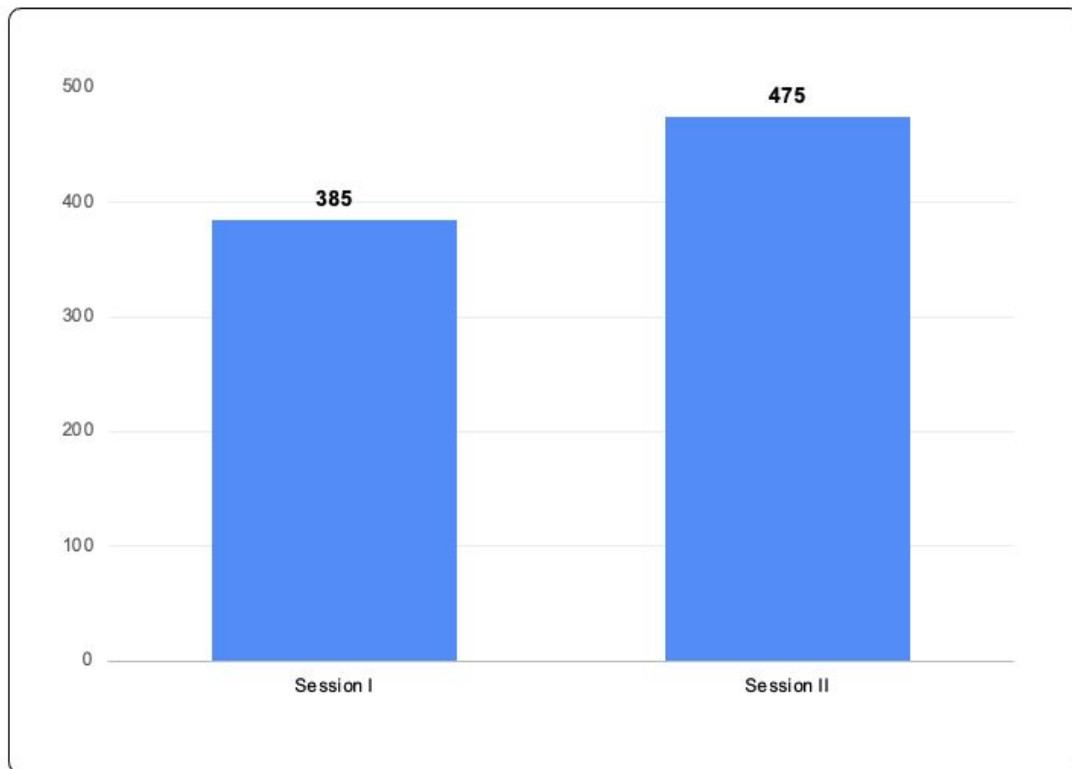

One Program, One Vision:

This summer, the Migrant Education, Expanded Learning (ELO), and Extended School Year (ESY) programs united under the shared theme "BizTown" to foster a powerful, inclusive learning community.

- ♦ **Integrated Curriculum:** Connected literacy, mathematics, and financial literacy directly with career exploration and hands-on activities.
- ♦ **Real-World Readiness:** Delivered meaningful, engaging lessons that prepared students with practical life skills and a strong sense of community.



An Inclusive Summer Learning Model



Collaborative Teacher Teams

- ◆ General Education, Special Education, Migrant, and ELO teachers planned and taught together.
- ◆ Shared responsibility for instruction, enrichment, and student success.
- ◆ Daily collaboration ensured students received individualized support within inclusive classrooms.



Inclusive Learning Model

Full Inclusion: Learning Center (LC) and Mild/Moderate (MSN) students learned alongside their peers.

Partial Inclusion:

Moderate/Extensive Support (ESN), IBI, and SEAS students participated in core instruction and specials.

Intervention Techs: Provided targeted small-group support to meet diverse learning needs.

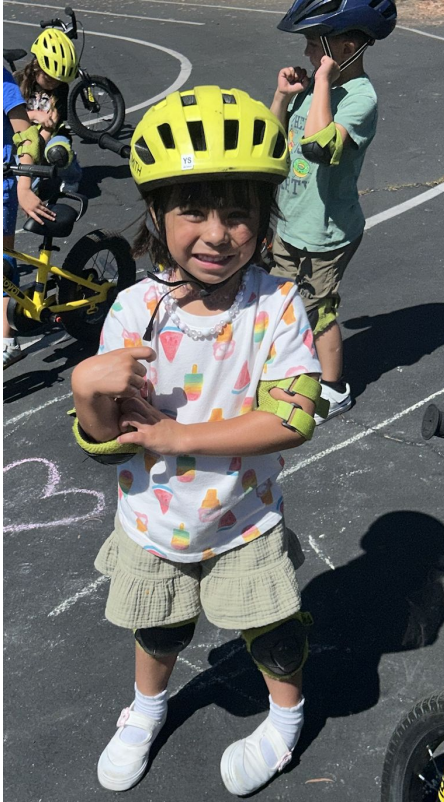
